Brush

Hair Pins

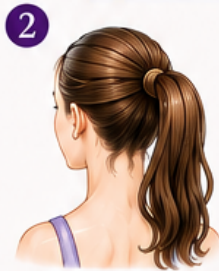


Bobby Pins

## CLASSIC BALLET BUN – STEP BY STEP



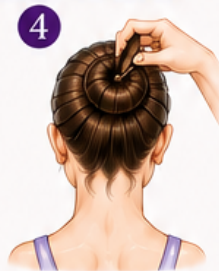
1  
Brush hair thoroughly and gather it into a high, tight ponytail.



2  
Use water or gel to smooth down flyaways and secure the hair.



3  
Twist the ponytail tightly, keeping it close to the head.



4  
Wrap the twisted hair around the base of the ponytail to form a bun.



5  
Add 1 / 2 U-shaped hair pin(s) to secure the bun.



6  
Place the hairnet over the bun and secure it neatly.



7  
Remove the U-shaped hair pin(s) and gently flatten and shape the bun using your hands.



8  
Secure the bun again with U-shaped hair pins and bobby pins for a neat and firm finish.



### TIP

A well-prepared bun shows discipline, care and respect for your training and your art.



## U-SHAPED HAIR PINS VS BOBBY PINS

### U-SHAPED HAIR PINS



- Stronger & longer
- Used to secure the bun structure

### BOBBY PINS



- Smaller & flexible
- Used for stray hairs and extra hold

Use both together for the most secure and elegant result.
